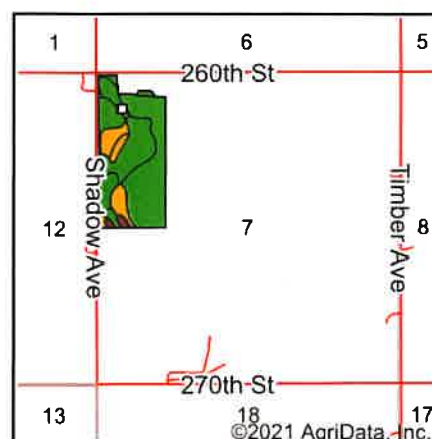

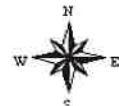
Soils Map
