#### **SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

The sale will be structured with a split closing on a standard installment contract for deed. Half of the purchase price will be paid immediately prior to December 31st, 2025. The balance will be paid as soon as possible after January 1st, 2026. The funds collected must be by wire transfer to the Trust Account of Benchmark Agribusiness, Inc. or by certified check(s).

The buyer will have outright possession for the 2026 season. The buyer may begin any drainage tiling, fall tillage and fall crop input applications immediately after the existing CRP contract expires on October 1st, 2025. Any investment made by the pending buyer prior to closing and prior to full possession will be at the buyer's risk in the unlikely event the buyer can't perform on the purchase contract.

Real Estate taxes will be pro-rated to date of closing. Unpaid special assessments (if applicable) to be paid by the seller. The semi-annual installments due September 30, 2025 and March 31, 2026 will be paid by the seller.

Any perimeter fences are assumed, but not guaranteed to coincide with the property lines. If the buyer wants a new survey, the buyer must pay the cost of the survey. The final purchase price is <u>not</u> dependent upon the results of a new certified survey.

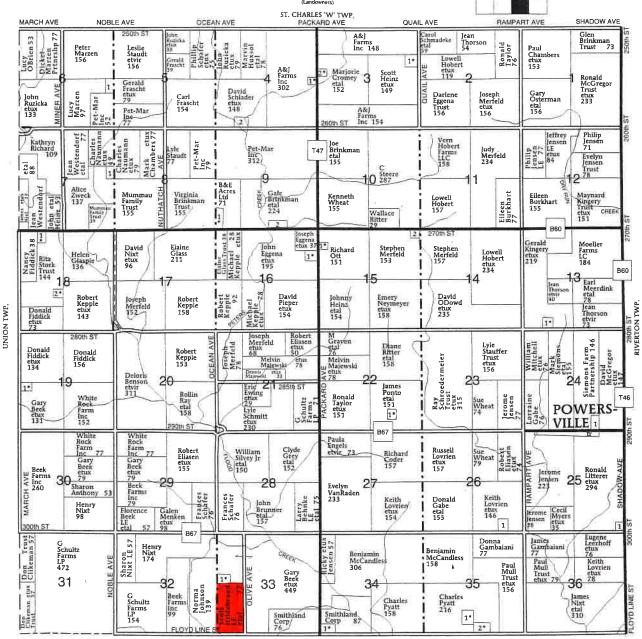

#### AMENDMENT TO DRAINAGE AGREEMENT AND EASEMENT REGARDING

TRACT I: THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (W% SW%) OF

SECTION THIRTY-THREE (33), TOWNSHIP NINETY-FOUR (94) NORTH, RANGE SIXTEEN (16) WEST OF THE 5<sup>TH</sup> P.M., FLOYD COUNTY, IOWA,

AND

TRACT II: THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER (E½ SE½) AND THE

SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (SE% NE%) OF SECTION THIRTY-TWO (32), TOWNSHIP NINETY-FOUR (94) NORTH, RANGE SIXTEEN (16) WEST OF THE 5<sup>TH</sup> P.M., FLOYD COUNTY, IOWA.

1. PARTIES IDENTIFIED. This Agreement is executed among:

"Hildebrands"

Skipper J. Hildebrand and Pamela J. Hildebrand, a married couple, and

Sandra K. Hildebrand, single, and

"Johnson"

C N Johnson, LLC, an Iowa limited liability company.

2. <u>CONSIDERATION</u>. This Instrument is executed for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged.

#### BACKGROUND.

- A. Hildebrands own Tract I.
- B. Johnson owns Tract II.
- C. The Tracts are adjacent, with the west boundary of Tract I sharing the east boundary of Tract II.

- D. By Agreement filed November 25, 2013 as Document No. 2013-2924, the parties addressed drainage.
- E. Crossing through the northerly part of Tract II is an 8 inch "Tile Main," with which Hildebrands have made a connection.
- F. The Tile Main runs generally northerly and northwesterly through the northerly portion of Tract II.

#### 4. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>.

- A. Document No. 2013-2924 is amended to refer to the Tracts referred to in the caption of this document.
- B. The expenses of the inspection, maintenance, repair, and replacement of the Tile Main shall be shared 50% by Hildebrands and 50% by Johnson.
- 5. <u>CONFIRMATION</u>. As amended, the Agreement filed as Document No. 2013-2924 is ratified and confirmed.
